Season Schedule:

- Full season (morning and afternoon practices) runs from mid-June through late July
- Practices and meets typically held Monday through Saturday

Required Qualifications:

- Minimum age: 18 years
- Proven competitive swimming background
- Previous coaching experience, preferably with MCSL summer swim league
- Current certifications:

 - Pool Operator
- Comprehensive knowledge of MCSL rules and procedures
- Expertise in teaching all four competitive strokes, starts, and turns
- Ability to teach and improve swimmers' skills for all four strokes, turns, and starts
- Strong leadership, communication and interpersonal skills, organization and management skills, and the ability to work in a positive and supportive manner with children of all ages and ability levels, as well as with their parents and leaders of the club
- Experience with meet management software (SwimTopia preferred)

Essential Responsibilities:

Practice & Meet Management

- Plan and lead all practice sessions (A, B, and Mini teams)
- Develop weekly meet lineups
- Direct team operations at:
 - Weekly A and B meets
 - Time Trials
 - Mini meets
 - Relay Carnival
 - Coaches Long Course
 - Divisionals
 - Relay and Individual All Stars
- Arrive 60 minutes before morning practice to check pool chemistry (mid-June through season end)

Team Leadership & Development

- Mentor and supervise assistant and junior coaches
- Provide constructive technique feedback to swimmers
- Demonstrate proper form and technique to swimmers by providing constructive feedback during practices and meets
- Foster a positive, inclusive team environment
- Participate in team social events and spirit activities
- Maintain clear communication with swimmers, parents, and board members
- Coordinate junior coach scheduling and development

Administrative Duties

- Attend required MCSL coaching clinics and meetings
- Prepare and submit meet-related documentation
- In consultation with coaching staff prepare and submit official paperwork and electronic files as required for every meet including weekly meets, relay carnivals, coaches invitational, divisional, and Allstars meets
- Assist in planning end-of-season awards ceremony
- Regular communication via email regarding upcoming events
- Meet with QV team board as needed to address team matters.
- Work with assistant coaches and Jr. Coaches at all practices and meets
- Coordinate and oversee Jr. Coaches practice schedule
