Season Schedule:

- Full season (morning and afternoon practices) runs from mid-June through late July
- Practices and meets typically held Monday through Saturday

Required Qualifications:

- Proven competitive swimming background
- Previous coaching experience, preferably with MCSL summer swim league
- Current certifications:
 - o Lifeguard
 - o CPR/AED
 - First Aid
- Familiarity with the meets, rules and procedures of the MCSL
- Ability to teach and improve swimmers' skills for all four strokes, turns, and starts
- Strong leadership, communication and interpersonal skills, organization and management skills, and the ability to work in a positive and supportive manner with children of all ages and ability levels, as well as with their parents and leaders of the club
- Very engaged in the team and with the swimmers to create a fun, rewarding experience for all team members
- Experience with meet management software (SwimTopia preferred)

Essential Responsibilities:

Practice & Meet Management

- Attend all A, B and Mini practices, meets and Time Trials
- Work with the Head Coach to plan and lead all practice sessions (A, B, and Mini teams)
- Work with the Head Coach to develop, generate and post weekly line-ups.
- Work with the Head Coach to lead and manage the team at
 - Weekly A and B meets
 - Time Trials
 - Mini meets
 - Relay Carnival
 - Coaches Long Course
 - o Divisionals
 - Relay and Individual All Stars
- Work with the Head Coach and Jr. coaches to plan, implement and refine workouts sets for each practice, meet line-ups, and activities.

Team Leadership & Development

- Demonstrate proper form and technique to swimmers by providing supportive and constructive feedback during practices and meets
- Provide technical coaching to swimmers of different ages and abilities to help them improve their stroke technique, fitness, and race components (starts and turns). This includes in-water stroke instruction.
- Work with the Head Coach to plan, implement and refine workouts sets for each practice, meet line-ups, and activities.
- Foster a positive, inclusive team environment
- Participate in team social events and spirit activities
- Maintain clear communication with swimmers, parents, and board members
- Work with the Head Coach to Mentor and supervise junior coaches
- Work with coaching staff at all practices and meets
- Work with Head Coach to provide information and feedback to parents and team representatives regarding swimmer needs and concerns that may arise.

Administrative Duties

- Attend required MCSL coaching clinics and meetings
- Work with Head Coach on preparing meet-related documentation
- Work with Head Coach on regular communication via email regarding upcoming events
- Meet with QV team board as needed to address team matters
- Work with the Head Coach to coordinate junior coach scheduling and development
- Assist in planning end-of-season awards ceremony
- Attending scheduled events as directed by team representatives, including weekly spirit events, meetings, and pre-season events to greet families and register swimmers.
- Work with the Head Coach to select and identify swimmers for awards
