



Rockville Rays Assistant Coach – Summer 2025

The City of Rockville, Recreation and Parks Department is seeking a 2025 assistant coach for the Rockville Rays. The Rays are part of the Montgomery County Swim League (MCSL), competing over the summer swim season. The team has over 200 swimmers, practices Monday through Friday, with meets on Saturday mornings, and some Wednesday Evenings / Sunday Mornings. The goal of the team is to provide an opportunity for children ages 5-18 to have fun, build self-confidence, teamwork and good sportsmanship through competitive swimming.

Swim Coach (Rays Assistant Coach) Job Summary:

Usually works under the supervision of a Senior Coach or Head Coach to instruct and supervise swim team participants at team practices, meets and other activities, however is expected to occasionally lead practice sessions and other activities independently, as directed. Work schedule throughout the MCSL season will include practices on weekday afternoons, meets on Saturday mornings and Wednesday evenings, as well as various team events.

General Responsibilities Include:

- Conducting practices and workouts for swim team members.
- Maintaining a safe environment at practices and meets.
- Completion of all paperwork and administrative processes which are related to swim team activities and meets.
- Supervising swimmers at meets.
- Professionally communicating with swimmers and parents to provide information. pertaining to the swim team and general customer service.
- Completing routine facility maintenance to include set-up and clean-up of practice area.
- Responding to any emergency situation which may arise.
- Other duties as assigned.

Qualifications:

Certification in Safety Training for Swim Coaches, CPR/AED and First Aid required and Lifeguard Training certification is preferred. Ability to communicate effectively in a pool environment and demonstrate competitive swimming strokes and techniques is required. May be required to attend related training sessions and possess or be able to obtain Coach's Certification from USA Swimming.

Experience: Must have competitive swimming background. Prior experience as a Swim Coach or Swim Instructor preferred.

Education: High school diploma preferred.
